# Way Check Method of Personal Evangelism

**Lesson Objective:** To show how to be an effective soul-winner by eliminating the use of man's opinions and allowing God to speak only through His Word.

Use the "ruler demonstration" to set ground rules for this study. Select an object in the room to measure. Have students guess at its length. Ask if we all can agree on the correct length. Have a measuring tape or ruler available to prove we can agree and get the correct answer without any division or confusion.

Our Ruler – The Bible – Phil 3:16, II Tim 3:16 – Ground Rule: Neither the teacher nor the student is allowed to guess or offer opinions when answering questions. Answers for all questions **MUST** be supported by scripture.

## Who Will Go To Heaven? Let's ask the Lord!

### 1. Lord, Who Will Go to Heaven?

**Mat 7:21** Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.


### 2. What is the Will of Jesus' Father?

**Joh 7:16** Jesus answered them, and said, My doctrine is not mine, but his that sent me.

**Joh 7:17** If any man will do his will, he shall know of the doctrine, whether it be of God, or whether I speak of myself.

### 3. What Doctrine must we know?

**2Jo 1:9** Whosoever transgresseth, and abideth not in the doctrine of Christ, hath not God. He that abideth in the doctrine of Christ, he hath both the Father and the Son.



### 4. What Doctrine must we avoid?

**Mat 15:8** This people draweth nigh unto me with their mouth, and honoreth me with *their* lips; but their heart is far from me.

### 5. What heart is Jesus speaking of?

**Mat 15:18** But those things which proceed out of the mouth come forth from the heart; and they defile the man.

**Mat 15:19** For out of the heart proceed evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, blasphemies:

### 6. What Doctrine must we avoid?

**Mat 15:9** But in vain they do worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men.

### 7. What did these poor souls not know?

- The Doctrine of Christ – Singular

### 8. What causes them to worship Jesus in Vain?

**Mat 15:9** But in vain they do worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men.

- Teaching Doctrines of Men – Plural

## 9. Compare Doctrine of Christ to Doctrines of Men (Examples)

### DOCTRINES OF MEN

VS.

### DOCTRINE OF CHRIST

No Baptism necessary	Believe + Baptism = Saved (Mark 16:16)
Pray the Sinner's Prayer	God doesn't hear sinners (John 9:31)
Any church will do	Christ said "My church" (Matt 16:18)
Church of choice	One church (Eph 4:4, Col 1:18)
Father, Reverend	Christ said "Call no man Father" (Matt 23:7-9); Holy, Reverend is God (Psa 111:9)
Division by Denominations/"Non-denom"	Christ said "No divisions" (I Cor 1:10)
Nothing in a name	No other name (Acts 4:10-12)

## 10. Few versus the Many

**Mat 7:13** Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide *is* the gate, and broad *is* the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat:

**Mat 7:14** Because strait *is* the gate, and narrow *is* the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.

- Few will FIND IT - The Way of Truth!
- Many will Go the Way of Destruction – Never find the Way of Truth!

**Mat 7:22** Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works?

**Mat 7:23** And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.

## **11. THE SAD CONCLUSION**

**MANY will not go. Will YOU?**

**Conclusion** – Without the teacher's input, the student should be able to identify from this lesson whether they are among the Many or the Few. Using a board or pad to illustrate visual aids will be most effective. It is important to remember the Father's Will is for us to KNOW and share the Doctrine of Christ which always includes the gospel of Jesus Christ. Make sure you are doing the Father's Will!
